Louisanna Alford claimed to have been born in Missouri. Some researchers have listed Kansas as her place of birth, also some census records. She may have been born at the home of her jasper relatives who lived in Missouri at the time of her birth.

Louisanna was a beautiful woman, small of stature and had very dark hair and eyes.

Louisanna married Albert Buchanan Cummings in Troy, Doniphan County, Kansas on 10 September 1877. Albert Cummings worked on a railroad. They were living in Harper County, Kansas in 1885 and moved to Union County, Oregon by train in 1892.

Louisanna and Albert were later divorced but remained friends. They are buried side by side along with their daughter Caroline and son Gaston in the Summerville Cemetery, in the Merrill Jasper plot, in Summerville, Union County, Oregon.

According to a descendant of Louisanna Alford, recent research has surfaced that her grandmother, Jemima Harris Jasper, was Indian. Therefore the dark hair and eyes. Family members remember Louisanna as being very dark and stern. She was very independent. Sometimes she used the name Louise and sometimes Anna Alford, taking back her maiden name after her divorce.

It appears that Louisanna, her husband and children all came to Oregon about the same time as did her sister, Rhoda Jane. They appear to have been drawn to the community where their uncle Merrell Jasper lived (their mother, Sally Ann Jasper's brother). Louisanna's older brothers Austin Alford and James Alford came to their uncle Merrell Jasper's several years before their sisters came.
